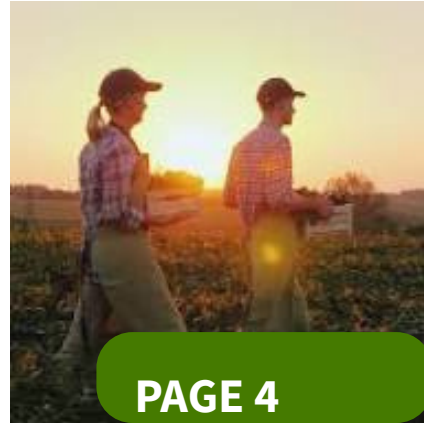

Mamaiana



Raluca Negru, representative of the Carpathian Organic Hub cluster, is an important participant in Organic Climate Net.

Mamaiana Farm in Argeş County is a family business that processes its own crops, launching a range of organic products made from wheat and sunflowers.



"We focused on our basic production, wheat and sunflower, and obtained flours, whole wheat flour and semolina obtained at a stone mill, and from sunflower cold-pressed, high-oleic extra virgin organic oil," explained Raluca Negru.
